Saraba Magazine has emerged as one of the foremost publishers of new and emerging literary talent in Nigeria and Africa. Many of the writers published in Saraba have earned literary acclaim. Previous contributors include Uche Peter Umez, Elnathan John, Tolu Ogunlesi, Chika Unigwe, Ayobami Adebayo, Victor Ehikhamenor, Ikeogu Oke, Dike Chukwumerije, Okwiri Oduor, Jumoke Verissimo, Clifton Gachagua, Ukamaka Olisakwe, Donald Molosi, Eghosa Imasuen, Abubakar Adam Ibrahim and Tade Ipadeola. Annually, Saraba releases 2 regular issues, 2 poetry chapbooks and 2 special issues. Up to 300 writers have been published by the magazine since its first issue in February 2009.

Driven by the necessity to highlight the work of the finest young poets working in Nigeria and Africa, Saraba has also published poetry chapbooks. These chapbooks have sought out the most brilliant poets working in Nigeria, and have been ambitious in outlook and form. In 2011, collaborating with the UK-based Poetry Translation Centre, Saraba published a chapbook of translated poetry from around the world. In 2013, we launched the Individual Poetry Chapbook series, and have now published collections by Jumoke Verissimo, Umar Abubakar Sidi, Kola Tubosun, and Dami Ajayi.

Saraba, in each publication, offers a reflection of the world, and how literature can speak to, about, and for, basic human interaction. Each magazine issue is based on a theme, and downloaded at least 2,000 times. From 2011 to 2013, in collaboration with PEN Nigeria, Saraba awarded a yearly poetry prize for the best poem published within its pages.

Saraba's prominence was further established with the launching of the 2015-2016 Manuscript Project. Up to 10 fiction and nonfiction manuscripts by emerging Nigerian writers will be published in print, and as e-books and audio books.



REQUIREMENTS & DISCOUNTS

For magazine and chapbook advertisement placement, JPEG, PNG, or TIFF files with minimum of 300 dpi resolutions are preferred and they should be received four weeks before the next issue is due. Discount of 20% is available to booking for up to four publications.
